

<b>DMSB – Regulations 2024 Rundstrecke - Road Racing - IRRC</b>

These Supplementary Regulations shall be based on the currently valid version of the FIM sporting Code, the DMSB Motorcycle Regulations (DMSG), the DMSB Regulations for Road Racing, the IRRC Sporting and technical regulations, the DMSB Environment Guidelines, the DMSB License Regulations, the DMSB Code of Ethics, the DMSB Legal System and Procedure (RuVO), the Anti-Doping-Regulations of the national and international Anti-Doping Agency (NADA/WADA) and the Anti-Doping Regulations of the FIM.

For other series, the regulations (sporting and technical regulations) of the respective series also apply. Unless otherwise stipulated in these regulations, the provisions of the above mentioned regulations apply.
