

# Regulations for the 61st International Frohburg ADAC Dreieck Race 14./15.09.24

1. All laws and regulations of the DMSB, the German Sports Act and the organizer's supplementary regulations of 13.07.2024 apply.

### 2. Training

- The paddock announcements must be observed
- The driver is responsible for arriving on time for training
- The start of training is displayed in the pre-start area
- In the 1st practice session in each class, the first lap is driven behind the safety car, there is a strict ban on overtaking
- The time limit in qualifying for the race of classes 5 and 6 is 112%, and 115% for class 7
- Newcomers have to wear a yellow vest, which is available at the Welcome Center
- After the end of the training, there is no out lap. All riders leave the track before the Bridgestone corner in the direction to the paddock! The Marshalls' flags are to be observed!

#### 3. Race

- Schedule changes will be posted on the information board and announced via the paddock announcer
- After the end of the race, an out lap occurs
- The award ceremonies of the Saturday races will take place on Saturday at 7.30 p.m. in the marquee
- The award ceremonies of the races on Sunday will take place after the respective race
- In classes 3 and 4, the award ceremony will be held by the series manager according to his own regulations
- Participation in the award ceremonies is mandatory!
- Every vehicle involved in an accident is taken to the technical inspection / scrutineering and will only be released for collection by the technical commissioners
- Starting exercises are prohibited!

### 4. Paddock

- The paddock will be open from Thursday 13.09.24 6:00 p.m.
- If you arrive in advance, you can use the designated campsites in the area
- The stand in the paddock is assigned by paddock marshals, prior reservation and staking of claims is prohibited, the instructions must be followed
- The disposal of used oil and tyres at the paddock is prohibited
- Violations will lead to immediate or future exclusion from the event
- Electricity must be used sparingly
- Riders meetings see schedule, participation is mandatory
